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GUHSD MENTORING PROGRAM

The nationally acclaimed GUHSD Mentoring Program, which began in 1995, lends greater support to new teachers in the district.

The primary goal of the program is to help new teachers improve their teaching skills by facilitating teacher thinking no matter what point a mentee is at in their career. With the mentor's help, teachers develop at a faster rate than they would without the support, thus improving both performance and retention rates of new hires in the Glendale Union High School District.

Unlike other mentoring programs, one mentor teacher is assigned to each of the nine high schools in the district. They are responsible for supporting all 1st-3rd year teachers who are new to the district on their local campus. They also work together as a collaborative team to conduct professional development workshops for new teachers.

The GUHSD Mentoring Program is designed to acclimate new teachers to the district and the profession. The mentors serve as a valuable resource to

facilitate connective relationships between new and veteran teachers.

Local mentors provide coaching to new teachers to improve lesson plans and lesson delivery and serve as a model/example in teaching.
