## IHBA SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS AND ACCOMMODATIONS FOR DISABLED STUDENTS

## (Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973)

It is the responsibility of the District to identify, evaluate and provide a free appropriate public education (FAPE)as necessary to ensure that a student eligible under Section 504 has equal access to services, programs and activities offered to students without disabilities. Under this policy, a student who may need special services or programs within the intent of Section 504 is one who:

- Has a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one (1) or mores major life activities which include, but are not limited to, caring for oneself,s performing manual tasks, walking, hearing, seeing, speaking, breathing,s learning and working, eating, sleeping, standing, lifting, bending, reading,s concentrating, thinking, and communicating); ors
- Has a record of such impairment or is regarded as having such impairment;s ands
- Requires regular or special education and related aids and services that ares
  designed to meet the individual needs of the student as adequately as thes
  needs of non-disabled students.s
